SURREY FIELD SHOOT 2010

REPORT

High Ashurst facilities have had a large injection of lottery funding since last years shoot. New buildings were still under construction and a lot of the area had not yet recovered from the building activities, with much mud rather than grass in evidence.

Nevertheless very little, if any, of 'our' wooded area used for field shooting had been lost to development. The facilities are so new that we had to take our boots and shoes off to enter the magnificent new hall for prize giving.

The weather was kind to us and it stayed dry all day. We had one of the best turnouts for years with 68 shooting on the day, with only 4 no-shows who had already paid. This was really helpful as the rearranging of target groups at the start of the shoot can be very vexing with too many no shows.

After assembly at 9am, shooting started at 9.30, and then recommenced after lunch at 12.30. The first groups finished at 3pm, and the very efficient prize giving by Cliff and Pauline allowed everyone to leave for home at about 4pm. What would we do without computers. Scores were high and two national records were broken, one by Daisy Clark (Ladies Compound Unlimited Under 18), and the other by Megan Elm (Ladies Compound Unlimited Under 15).

Judging was expertly carried out by Hannah Brown assisted by Derrick Lovell and Netta Bridle, with Victoria Hinchcliffe as a candidate judge. Nick, Jum and Greg supplied the hot food and drinks all day that were welcomed by all.

Our Lady Paramount for the day was Jane Lawrence-Tuck (County Secretary) who had not seen field shooting before, but confessed to wanting to have a go next year.

Last but not least my thanks go to the staff at High Ashurst without whose help and understanding the whole job of setting up the course, and subsequently removing it, would be made a lot harder.

Another last but not least, a big thank you to you the archers for bringing in the numbers and pegs etc., after the shoot.
